Vanuatu's allure lies in its natural beauty, cultural richness, and the warmth of its people, making it a captivating destination in the South Pacific.



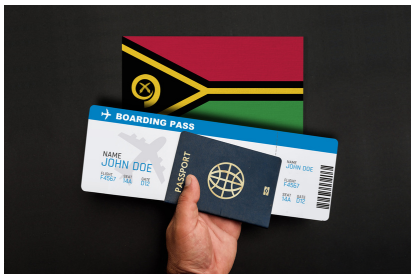
Quick Facts

Citizenship Program

Vanuatu also operates a Citizenship by Investment Program, providing individuals with an opportunity to acquire citizenship through investments in the country's economy. The program offers various investment pathways.

Visa-Free Travel: Vanuatu citizenship obtained through investment provides visa-free or visa-on-arrival access to numerous countries worldwide, facilitating travel to destinations across the globe.

Family Inclusion: The program allows the main applicant to include immediate family members, such as a spouse, dependent children, and sometimes dependent parents or grandparents, in the citizenship application, enabling the inclusion of the entire family unit.

Due Diligence: Similar to other reputable citizenship by investment programs, Vanuatu maintains stringent due diligence procedures. Thorough background checks, vetting processes, and investigations are integral to the application process, ensuring the program's security and upholding its integrity.

Investment Options

Development Support Program (DSP):

- The DSP in Vanuatu allows applicants to obtain citizenship by contributing to the country's development fund.

Real Estate Investment: (Not active)

- Another option involves investing in approved real estate projects within Vanuatu to qualify for citizenship.



Timeline

- **Application Submission:** The applicant submits the required documentation and completes the application.
- **Due Diligence:** The government conducts due diligence checks on the applicant, which can take several weeks.
- **Investment:** Upon approval, the applicant makes the selected investment.
- **Approval and Citizenship:** Once the investment is confirmed, and all criteria are met, citizenship is granted, usually within 2 to 3 months.
